## **Bader Primary School - Progression of writing**



## By the end of each term most children should:

- Demarcate SOME sentences with capital letters and full stops.
- Use spacing between words that reflects the size of the letters.
- Segment spoken words into phonemes and represent these by graphemes.
- Begin to use co-ordination (or, and, but) to join clauses.
- Some correct use of exclamation marks.

- Demarcate MOST sentences with capital letters and full stops.
- Use question marks correctly SOME of the time.
- Use past and present tense mostly correctly and consistently.
- Use co-ordination effectively to join clauses.

- Write simple, coherent narratives.
- Spell MANY Year 1 and Year 2 common exception words.
- Use SOME sub-ordination to join clauses (when, if, that, because)
- Form ALL letters correctly, including capital letters and
- digits.
